Re: Technology Department Update

OVERVIEW OF PAST MONTH:

1. It has been a frantic few weeks to get all the last of the wells up and running before the busy season. There were motors that needed to be wired to drives, level transducers replaced, electrically actuated valves to be configured, etc. These projects ran late because of the well pullers schedules and delays but all are up and ready for the year ahead.

At our Sun Peak Well 3 location we had been working on getting our electrical service replaced as it was outdated, no longer met code and was causing us issues late last summer. The work included a new meter base, external disconnect and new conductors run into the building. This site is unusual as the incoming power is only 240V single phase and we have a step up transformer(replaced 2 years ago) that converts it to 480v three phase power for the pump. This load put extra strain on the aging meter base and breaker and since completing the project we haven't had any electrical related issues at this site and the well has been running regularly.

Mike has been working on conduit and wiring for the Atkinson Well 2 ASR project that Sam is working on. We have wired in a new flow meter and an actuator valve for that system.

2. All the Seasonal Summer help has started and they have completed all the required on boarding, assigned safety training. They have been brought up to speed on using OpenGov on dedicated iPads to receive and track their field work. Currently they are working on annual hydrant maintenance and inspections.
