Chief Procurement Officer Justification:

Nature of the Emergency: Atkinson Well #2 experienced a pump failure; during retrieval of the pump, a 2-inch injection pipe was broken and fell down the well. Restoring this well to operational status is critical to the District's water supply, which is directly tied to public health and safety. Widdison Well Services was dispatched to 'fish' the pipe and perform a standard brush and bail of the well prior to well equipping. **Cost Increases:** While the initial estimate for this work was significantly lower, the vendor encountered unforeseen downhole conditions. Specifically, the well was obstructed by approximately 84 feet of pea gravel fill blocking the bottom well screens. To safely access and extract the broken pipe, we removed material by mobilizing a 1000 CFM air compressor and performing multi-day airlifting operations. The pipe was also deformed and the 2-inch fishing equipment originally used was not able to retrieve the pipe. An additional video was required after the air lift to choose the correct fishing tools. Ultimately, the pipe was successfully removed and the well casing was brushed. **Section 3.2.5 of the Mountain Regional Water Procurement Policy:** This purchase is an Emergency Procurement. This procurement was made with as much competition as reasonably practicable under the circumstances, while ensuring the rapid deployment of a specialized well pump rig and fishing equipment (and expertise) to avoid a prolonged lapse in critical government services.
