

Afterwards, Administrator Zeldin met with Mountain Regional Water staff and toured their Signal Hill Water Treatment Plant. This facility received \$38 million in Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act (WIFIA) loan funding to plan, design, and construct improvements to increase treatment capacity and implement new treatment processes to help remove emerging contaminants. These upgrades will more than double the facility's treatment capacity to accommodate the projected population growth within the Park City area. Additionally, the project will establish source reliability by improving treatment methods to address increased contaminants in the watershed
